BWP/NAD attempts to serve as many regional sites as we can every year across North America. For sites to operate outside the continental US (Canada, Mexico, Hawaii, Caribbean) a minimum number of horses equaling USD\$2000 in registrations, inside the continental US a minimum of \$1500 in registrations. If host has less than these amounts they may be asked to co-host or to travel to the next closest location.

STABLING AVAILABILITY

Stabling should be safe for all age groups of horses. Feeding and care is not required, however, this needs to be communicated to participants. Host can charge participants directly for use of stall, cleaning, feeding supplied feed, etc. If the need exceeds the number of stalls available, it is the responsibility of the host to find alternative boarding. Truck-in parking should also be available.

BWP/NAD ACCOMMODATIONS AND TRANSPORTATION

Site hosts must provide, arrange and pay for overnight accommodations for at least one BWP judge and one BWP/NAD representative, separate rooms must be provided. Hotels and local inns are sufficient, guest accommodations are also welcome as long as they can acceptably accommodate two people in separate quarters and provide a safe, allergen-free and clean space to stay.

**Transportation must be arranged by site host to and from the airport and accommodations. In some cases a rental is needed for multiple sites within a location - this expense can be divided among each host. To be discussed prior to final travel plans. Uber/Lyft is not an acceptable form of transportation - private livery with a licensed USDOT company can be used. Pick-up and drop-off by host is also acceptable. If using a limo company, all confirmations must be supplied to BWP/NAD. Confirmations for air travel will be given to site host to arrange transportation.

Accommodation and transportation can be split among participants, but must be communicated ahead of time. All additional fees should be approved by BWP/NAD prior to scheduling of inspection.
